### The Judgment

# Five Things You Should Know About Hell That Are Found in Scripture:

1. Hell is a <u>literal</u> place.

(Revelation 21:7-8) He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be my son. But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

2. Hell is a dark place.

(Matthew 8:12) But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Hell is an <u>awful</u> place.
(Matthew 13:42)...., and will cast them into the furnace of fire.

### 4. Hell is a permanent place.

(Matthew 25:41) "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angel."

5. Hell is an avoidable place.

(John 3:16) For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

(John 3:18) "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God (Hebrews 3:1-2) Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, who was faithful to Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house.

## The Escape Plan

1. God wants everyone to be in on the plan.

(1 Timothy 2:4) ... who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

(2 Peter 3:9) The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

2. God so loves you.

(Revelation 3:20) Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with me.
